

**MINUTES OF MEETING OF

ADAMS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA
June 11, 2025**

The Board of Supervisors Meeting Wednesday, June 11, 2025, was held at the Tyrone Township Municipal Building, 5280 Old Harrisburg Road, York Springs, PA 17372, Adams County, Pennsylvania.

Members Present: Chairman Mike Mosley, Vice Chairman Michele Migas, Supervisor Rosalie Dashoff, Roadmaster Chester Dabrowski, Secretary Dawn Felts.

Call to Order: Mosley called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

Pledge of Allegiance: Mosley led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Approval of Board of Supervisors Meeting Minutes:

Dashoff made a motion to approve the minutes for the May 14, 2025, Board of Supervisors Meeting. Migas seconded the motion. A vote was taken, and it was carried unanimously.

Approval and Payment of the Accounts Payable Invoices, Monthly Bank Run Statements and Credit Card Purchases for April 2025:

Migas made a motion to approve payment of the Accounts Payable Invoices made in May 2025, the monthly bank transactions, and credit card purchases for May 2025. Mosley seconded the motion. A vote was taken, and it was carried unanimously.

Old Business:

- Salt shed canvas roof was installed the week of May 19, 2025.
- Building outside lighting completed and updated security system installed. Passcodes alarmed at doors – 10 cameras placed within and outside of building.
- Road crack repair sealing has started. Township renting machine for two (2) weeks starting on Gun Club Rd. and extending to Funt Rd., Rupp Rd., Millar Rd. and possibly Bull Valley depending on time and material available.

New Business:

- Township received \$772.87 from PA State Police for fines collected through May 31, 2025.
- Currently 75 residents still outstanding for District 3 septic pumping that must be done by June 30, 2025.
- Auction closed at 4:00 PM on June 11, 2025 on the sale of the 1991 International truck that is no longer in service. Dashoff made a motion to accept the highest bid of \$3200.00. Migas seconded the motion. A vote was taken, and it carried unanimously.
- Inquiry regarding the Company Farm Rd. and Upper Bermudian Rd Intersection is going to be reviewed. Resident concern over corn and tall grass and the inability to see. Resident asked if sign(s) could be posted. The Roadmaster will inspect the area.
- Reservoir Road project – Tyrone Township placed an ad in the Gettysburg Times 6/13/2025 and 6/20/2025 requesting sealed bids that will open on July 9, 2025 at 10:00 at the Tyrone Township Building for Tar and Chipping of Reservoir Rd.

- The following road projects have been approved for 2025.
 - Tapeworm Rd – Culvert pipe #10, repair separation under road.
 - Gun Glub Rd – Repair pipe separation along east bound side.
 - Rock Valley Rd. – Concrete pipe separation.
 - East Chestnut Rd. – Concrete pipe separation.
