

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
TYRONE TOWNSHIP, ADAMS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA
JANUARY 20, 2016**

The Board of Supervisors Meeting for Wednesday January 20, 2016 was held at the Tyrone Township Municipal Building, 5280 Old Harrisburg Road, York Springs, PA 17372.

Members Present: Chairman Lee Roe, Vice-Chair James Lady, Supervisor Russell Raub, Secretary Mary Diehl

Call to Order: Chairman Lee Roe called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

Pledge of Allegiance: Chairman Lee Roe led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Approval of Previous Minutes: Raub made a motion to approve the minutes for December 30, 2016. Lady seconded the motion and the motion passed.

Lady made a motion to approve the Reorganization minutes for January 4, 2016. Raub seconded the motion and the motion passed.

Bills List: Russ made a motion to approve the bills list. Lady seconded the motion and the motion passed.

Public Comments on the Agenda: None

New Business: Township Treasurer Laura Weaver gave the Treasurer's Report.

Raub made a motion to adopt Chapter 7-A of Act 44 of 2009, Municipal Pension Plan Funding Standard and Recovery Act. Lady seconded the motion and the motion passed.

Old Business: Roe said that he was not in favor of the sewer payment request by a resident in the township. Raub agreed. The resident must pay in full for the permit before the township issues the permit.

Raub made a motion to accept Timothy Shultis, Township Solicitor's recommendation for outstanding sewer rents. A standard collection letter is sent on thirty days after a payment is due, by the Township Secretary. At ninety days past due the Township authorizes collection through the Municipal Claims and Tax Liens Act. Lady seconded the motion and the motion passed.

Raub made a motion to accept Timothy Shultis' recommendation for failure to connect according to Ordinance No. 2013-03, the Mandatory Connection Sewer Ordinance. To act on any and all who failed to connect to the township sewer system. Lady seconded the motion and the motion passed.

Public Participation: David Richwine asked if the township is doing anything for John Adamick.

David Richwine said that he is happy with Advance Disposal Services. Dan Diviney agreed. Dan Diviney said that originally the company crushed his trash can. They replaced that trash can with one that the mechanical truck can lift without destroying.

Adjournment: Raub made a motion to adjourn at 7:25 PM. Lady seconded and the motion passed.
