

**MINUTES OF MEETING
TYRONE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
ADAMS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA
June 10, 2026**

The Board of Supervisors Meeting for Wednesday, June 10, 2026 was held at the Tyrone Township Municipal Building, 5280 Old Harrisburg Road, York Springs, PA 17372, Adams County, Pennsylvania.

Members Present: Chairman Rosalie Dashoff, Vice Chairman Michele Migas, Supervisor Mike Mosley, Secretary Kelley Staub, Solicitor Tim Shultis

Others in Attendance: David Richwine, Bernie & Missy Weishaar, and Dan Crockett

Call to Order: Dashoff called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

Pledge of Allegiance: Dashoff led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Approval of Board of Supervisors Meeting Minutes:

Migas made a motion to approve the minutes from the May 13, 2026 Board of Supervisors Meeting, Mosley seconded it. A vote was taken and it was carried unanimously.

Approval and Payment of the May 2026 Accounts Payable Invoices and Credit Card Purchases:

Migas made a motion to approve payment of the Accounts Payable Invoices, as well as the payments made in the second check run of the previous month. Mosley seconded the motion. A vote was taken and it was carried unanimously.

Old Business:

- Migas made a motion to approve Trash Ordinance 2026-02 of Tyrone Township. Adams Co, PA Rules & Regulations for waste collection within the township. Mosley seconded the motion. A vote was taken and it was carried unanimously.
- On July 1, 2025 Tyrone Township presented NAREMA members a Draft MOU outlining the conditions for sharing the Emergency Mobile Truck. The Township never received a response. On June 10th the Chairman sent another letter to NAREMA stating that the members have 30 days to respond, after which the offer to share the EOC truck will expire.
- Mosley made a motion to approve NAREMA Emergency Safety Plan for 2026. Migas 2nd a vote was taken and it was carried unanimously.
- Mosley made a motion to accept the Bill of Sale for the sanitary sewer extension and pump station at 3050 Heidlersburg Rd serving Rutters. Migas seconded the motion. A vote was taken and it was carried unanimously.
- Mosley made a motion to approve the purchase of Crystal Ball, which is a monitoring system that will be more accurate in detecting and notifying how important the issue. This will save the Township funds on unnecessary trips to the plant for minor issues after hours. Migas 2nd a vote was taken and it was carried unanimously.

New Business:

- After discussion the Board of Supervisors declined to install an AED Machine at this time
- After discussion the Board decided to obtain several estimates to create a new Web-site due to the Adams County shut down
- After much discussion and participation from the meeting attendees the Supervisors deemed it is not necessary to change the septic notification letters at this time.
